The Department of Interior Architecture & Product Design (IAPD) is located within the College of Architecture, Planning and Design (APDesign), in a Land Grant University. Offering a unique blend of interior architecture, product design, and furniture design, our vibrant and supportive community of faculty and students are composed of 12 full time faculty and 110 students in second through fifth years. Admission to the program is competitive and occurs after the first year.

The department offers a five-year Master of Interior Architecture and Product Design program (MIAPD) as the first-professional degree. Accredited by the Council for Interior Design Accreditation (CIDA) since 1974 and also accredited by NASAD (the National Association for Schools of Art and Design), the IAPD program is built upon a 50-year tradition of providing students with a nationally recognized and innovative education.
