PAUL MARKENS
FMA, LEED AP BD+C
Founding Partner, substance architecture

Paul Markens, FMA, LEED AP is a founding Partner of substance architecture in Des Moines, Iowa, and is widely regarded as one of the leading design practitioners in the Midwest. During the last three decades, he has directed the design of significant corporate, residential, civic, and higher education facilities recognized with over 100 design awards - including more than 50 awards from the American Institute of Architects (AIA). These projects include the Principal Reworkshop Pavilion and Pump Station along the Des Moines River, the renovation of Eric Sposon's Owen E. Scott Chapel of Drake University and Des Moines' New Central Library with David Chipperfield Architects of London. In addition, he taught architectural design at Iowa State University (ISU) from 1998 to 2013, and is a frequent academic and professional design awards juror nationwide.

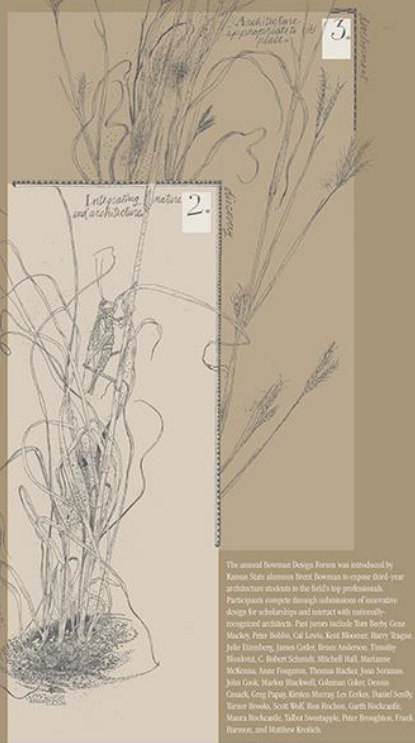
In recognition of his contributions to the profession, Paul received the Charter Achievement Award from ISU in 1998, the Young Architects Award from the AIA in 2003, and in 2004 he was elected to the AIA's College of Fellows. In 2011, Paul was named a Richard Lippitt Fellow of the AIA for his efforts leading the Institute, and in 2013 he received AIA Iowa's Medal of Honor - the highest honor the chapter can bestow on a member.

As a complement to his architectural work, Paul has served as Chair of the Greater Des Moines Public Art Foundation and as a member of the Board of Regents for the American Architectural Foundation in Washington, D.C. He holds degrees from Iowa State University (BA 1983) and Yale University (MArch 1991), and is the recipient of a research grant from the Graham Foundation for Advanced Studies in the Visual Arts.

Todd Garner has over 25 years of experience leading the design team efforts on projects of varying scales and complexity. His deep understanding of the construction process informs his approach to design and has allowed him to lead significant projects for Wells Fargo Financial, DAKT, Bromwell, ING Insurance, Bort, Nave Transportation, as well as other private and public sector works throughout Central Iowa. In addition, Todd has designed a number of award-winning interior projects including offices for ZIA Advertising and a retail space for Avon. Educated at Kansas State University, he returned to Des Moines in 1997 to start his professional career with Herbert Levin Kravis Bank, Architecture where he was named Principal in 2002. In 2003 he and his Partners formed substance architecture. Todd recently led the design team for the award-winning Corporate Campus Expansion, a 150,000 square foot, four-story office building, a 50,000 square foot, two-story software training center and a 1,400 vehicle parking structure.



The annual Bowman Design Forum was introduced by Kansas State alumni David Bowman to engage third-year architecture students in the field's top professionals. Participants compete through submission of creative designs for substipens and contract with nationally recognized architects.
