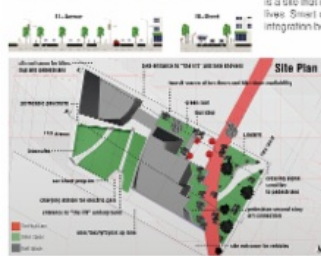
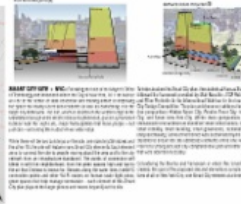


# BEYOND THE LINE

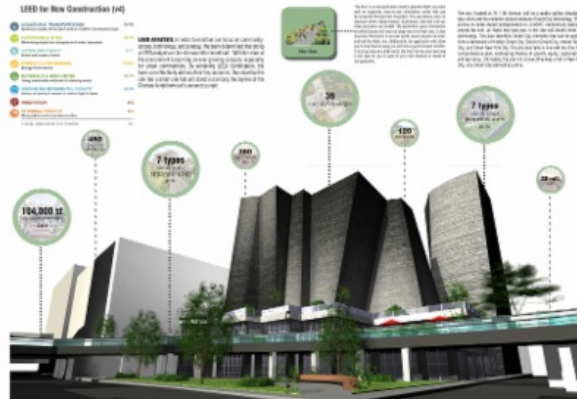

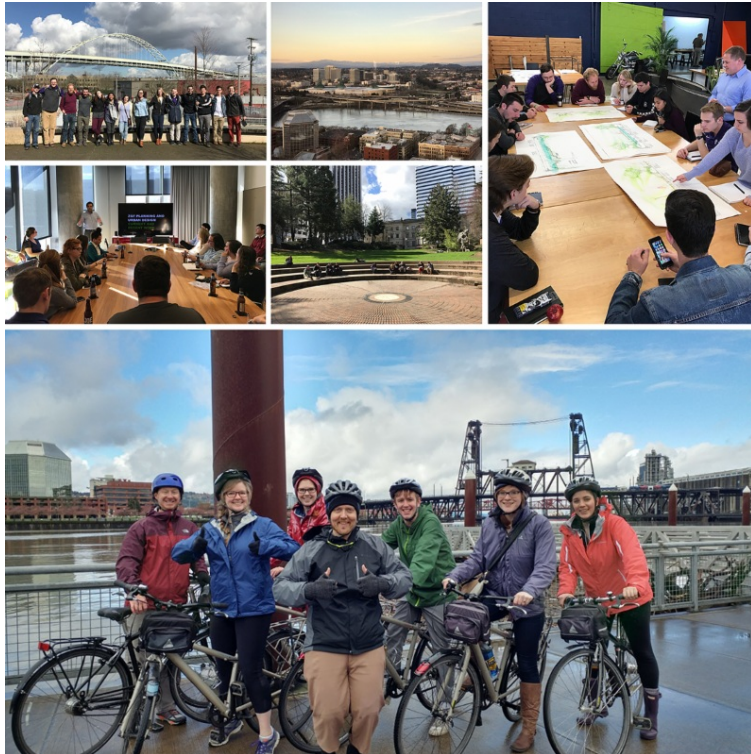
