The student selected will be presented with the Holstrom Award during Architecture Evening. The scholarship (in the amount of \$1000) is named in honor of John E. Holstrom, a 1968 initiate of the Alpha Tau Omega fraternity and a 1972 K-State graduate in architecture. Holstrom died in 1989 at the age of 40. Established with gifts from Holstrom's family, friends, and fraternity brothers, the Holstrom Scholarship is further endowed by a bequest from Holstrom's firm, WKA Architecture Inc., in Dallas, Texas. The award is normally presented at Architecture Evening by Holstrom's fraternity brother, Bill Muir, Assistant Vice President for Institutional Advancement at K-State.
