Visiting Professor Jay Siebenmorgen's fifth year design studio spent three days in New York last week.

The first day was spent touring precedent buildings throughout the city that would help the students think differently about their studio proposals. Two key buildings of which we had guided tours were the 41 Cooper Square building by Morphosis and the Campbell Sports Building by Steven Holl Architects.

The second day was spent touring Brooklyn neighborhoods with a guided tour of their project site - the Gowanus Canal, followed by a studio happy hour and dinner.

Thursday they visited the World Trade Center Observatory and spent the afternoon in the New York office of NBBJ. The KSU studio research was presented to the NBBJ office along with a presentation by Atelier 10 on Gowanus Canal and Resilient urban infrastructure.
