BIM Forward in the Agile Age



In the last decade and looking forward, the profession of architecture is facing a paradigm shift that is expected to change the entirety of how we as designers create spaces. While many of the concepts that are taking hold mainstream are not new, they are being applied in ways to our profession that before existed in the realm of science fiction. With the advent of BIM, parametric, and computational design, we look at a BIM-forward world that embraces change and technology. This lecture looks at how some of these concepts came to be, how architecture and BIM have been affected by rapid development of technology, and what the future holds for those getting ready to join the field. This will highlight several projects produced by BNIM Architects and focus on topics like building analytics and human purposed integrated design (HP.id).
