DESIGN CHARRETTE FOR WOUNDED WARRIORS' REHABILITATION AND FARM TRAINING CENTER DESIGN

APDesign Students from all disciplines are invited to participate in a design charrette to develop a master plan for a new farm training and healing center to serve the wounded soldiers and their family. This center is envisioned by SAVE (Soldier Agriculture Vocational Education) organization, and theywould like to develop a facilityto assist the wounded soldiers returning from Iraq and Afghanistan war. They hope to build this center in Manhattan, Kansas. This farm training and healing center will serve Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI), Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and severely injured amputees.

The charrette will be held at APDWest on September 21st evening at 6:30 P.M. 
