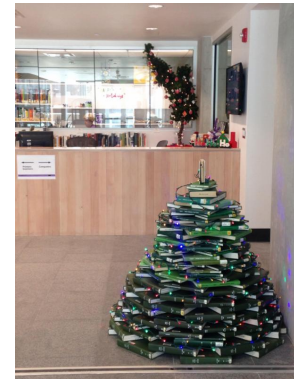
Cart and Crit Monitor Updates
