#### ISEP CONFERENCE | Ryadi Adityavarman Presented

Associate Professor Ryadi Adityavarman presented at the International Symposium on Education and Psychology Conference in Kyoto, Japan. His presentation topic - highlight



aspects of hidden dimensions of empathy and embodiment in the creative design process. The teaching reflection is analyzed through the lens of postmodern educational theory in embodied cognition with mindfulness as a pedagogical principle. At the conference, Ryadi discovered the Japanese concept of empathy "omoiyari" that inspired him to investigate its potential creative translation into design process for further research.
