Students present in Spain at ICERI Conference

Six Interior Architecture & Product Design Graduate students and associate professor Vibha Jani presented their papers and poster at the 10th International Conference on Education, Research and Innovation (ICERI) held in Seville, Spain November 16 - 18. These students collaborated to prepare research papers for their Design Research course taught by Prof. Jani in the fall of 2016. Jani had challenged her class to investigate how students utilize informal learning environments at institutes of higher learning. This subject resulted in four papers and two posters being accepted for publication and presentation at ICERI. Of the 24 students'

work accepted, only six students were able to attend the conference, including Zijun "Sunny" Zhao, Whitney Allen, Abigail Reese, Natalie Hill, Hana Robinson and Hannah Gwartney.

Presentations:

The paper "Influences of informal collaborative learning environments on the learning outcomes of students" presented by Sunny Zhao. Sunny co-authored this paper with Craig Farmer, Sloan Satterlee, and Malia Young.

The paper "Assessing millennial student dependability on technology within higher education collaborative environments" presented by authors Whitney Allen, Natalie Hill, Abigail Reese, and Hana Robinson.

Hannah Gwartney presented the poster "Anthropometrics and ergonomics in correlation to effective informal learning environments." Hannah collaborated with Madeline Appel, Jamie Causey, and Molly Gardner to prepare this research poster.

Professor Jani also presented her paper "Developing informal learning environments of tomorrow for institutes of higher education" during the ICERI conference.

ICERI is one of the largest international education conferences for educators, researchers, technologists and professionals with more than 700 experts from 80 countries presenting their research projects.

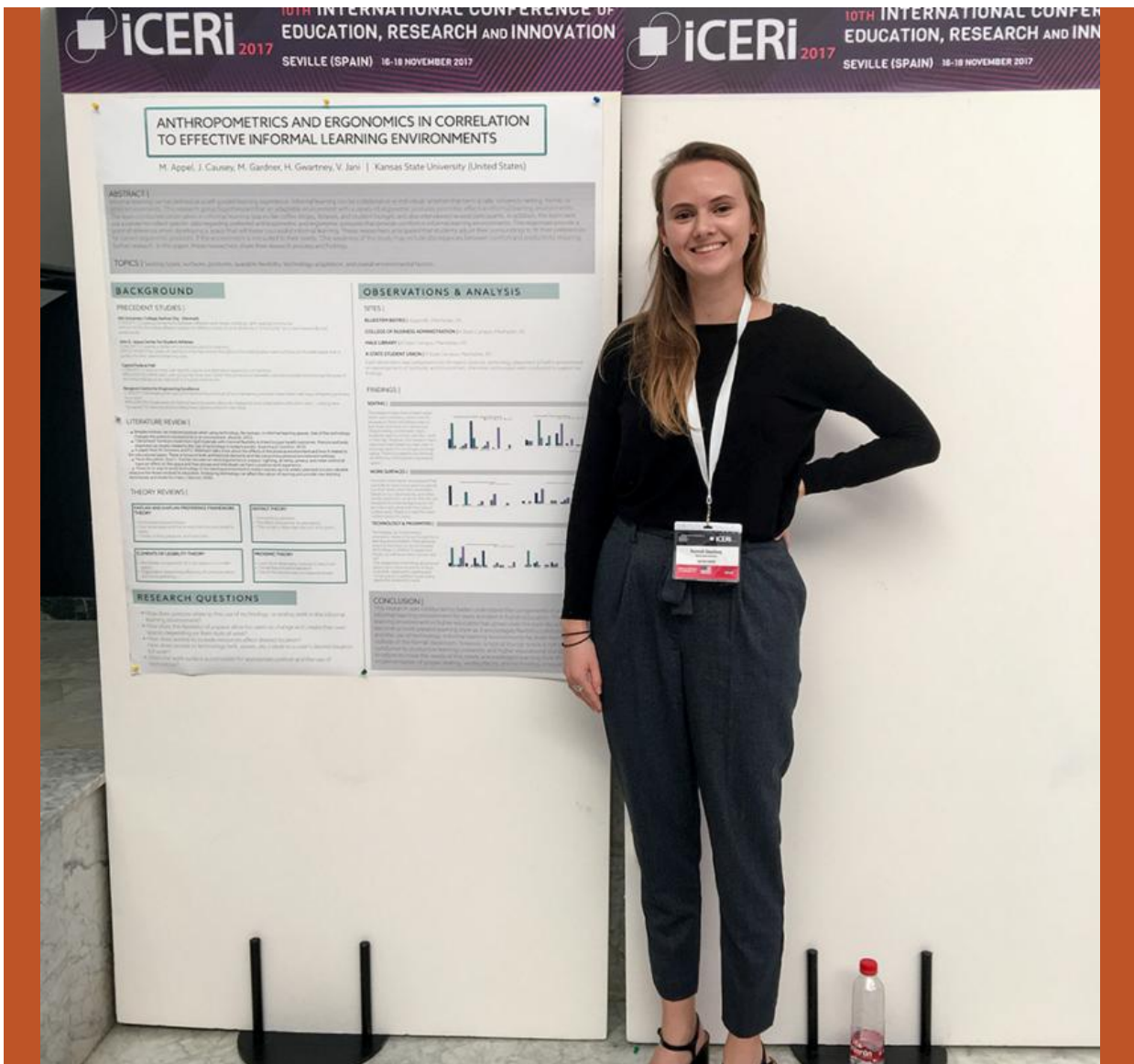

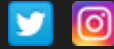
