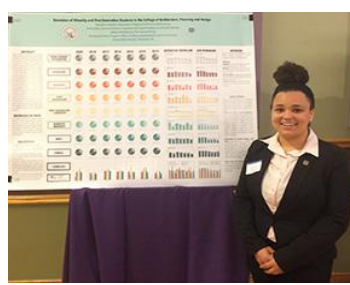
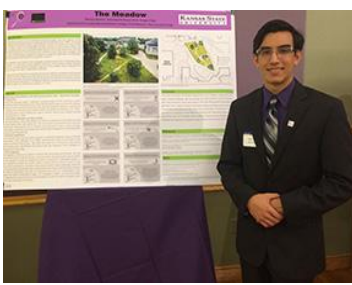

Assistant Professor Alpa Nawre presented the students' work to the Manhattan City Commission on Tuesday, April 4, with local design advocate Phil Anderson.

**Students in LAR 320 Site Design II** visited Emporia to inventory the Peter Pan Park on Tuesday, March 27. Assistant Professor Anne Beamish and Associate Professor Jessica Canfield are the instructors. Their work is a part of the collaborative re-imagining of Peter Pan Park with students in PLAN 672 Collective Decisions.

**PLAN 661 Community Develop Workshop** partnered with the Alumni Association, Chapman Center, and University Archives to capture the tangible and intangible relationships established by Memorial Stadium. They are collecting personal stories about the stadium, augmenting the Office of Military and Veterans Affairs historical study documenting the story of Memorial Stadium, built for the fallen 43 students alumni who died during World War I.
