Weigel Library - Third Floor Tidbits



Cha-ching!

As a patron of Weigel Library you are responsible for the materials you borrow. It is important you know the loan periods, due dates, and fee/fine charges for those materials. Otherwise it could cost you!

At the time of check out Weigel Library staff will tell you the due dates of the materials just loaned to you. Then they will send you via email an "activity report" providing an itemized list of library items in your possession and their due dates. That is the extent of their responsibility. You are ultimately accountable for the materials you check out and the fines you might incur!

Fine Charges -
 2-hour reserve - \$2 per hour, \$200 maximum
 1 to 7 day reserve - \$5 per day, \$70 maximum
 Recalls made by library staff - \$5 per day, \$25 maximum
 7 day loan (bound periodicals and media) - \$1 per day, \$7 maximum

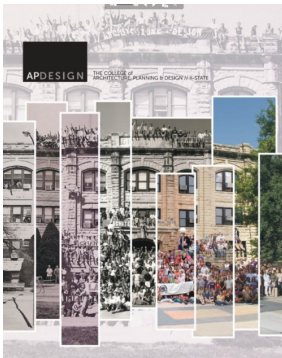
