Marlon Blackwell, FAIA, is a
practicing architect in
Fayetteville, Arkansas, and

serves as the E. Fay Jones Distinguished Professor at
the Fay Jones School of Architecture + Design at the
University of Arkansas. Working outside the architectural
mainstream, his architecture is based in design
strategies that draw upon vernaculars, typologies, and
the contradictions of place: strategies that seek to
transgress conventional boundaries for architecture. His
design work has received recognition with numerous
national and international design awards and significant
publication in books, architectural journals and
magazines.
