

Art of Architecture - a companion lecture to go with the current exhibition at The Box Gallery (closing August 26) - discussing the featured models of architectural landmarks - all using the LEGO® brick as a medium.

The exhibit is the work of LEGO Certified Professional Adam Reed Tucker, a former architect and Kansas State University alum who turned to the LEGO brick for inspiration. **The lecture will be at the Center for Architecture & Design, AIA Kansas City on Monday, August 29 at 6pm** with a reception following.

Art of Architecture includes 12 large-scale models that capture the essence of some of the most famous buildings in the world, including the Empire State Building, Jim Mao Tower, the Gateway Arch and the Willis Tower.

After earning degree in Architecture from Kansas State University's College of Architecture, Planning and Design, Tucker worked as an architect throughout the Kansas City and Chicago areas. Adam decided to leave his architecture job to focus on building with a new creative medium, the LEGO brick. In 2007 he became the 7th person to be a Lego Certified Professional -one of only 13 in the world.

Art of Architecture is on display through Aug. 26. The Box Gallery is located in the Commerce Bank Building at 1000 Walnut St., in Downtown KC. Hours are from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday-Friday. Admission is free and open to the public. The exhibit is a partnership with Kansas State University's College of Architecture, Planning and Design.
