STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT AS DEFINED BY THE PROGRAM

A signature experience of the MRCP program is completion of an independent capstone experience in the form of a Masters Project and Report or a Thesis. This project, supervised by a committee of Graduate Faculty, allows students to focus on a specific area of professional interest and, in the development of that project, demonstrate the highest level of professional competence they have achieved during their professional education.
